



24" Pipeline Free-span Rectification
Yadana Field, Myanmar
Q4 2017 / TRS2 CFE SPREAD



Rotech Subsea was contracted by Path-finder Technical Services Co, Ltd to provide free-span rectification services on the 24" Domestic Gas Myanmar Oil and Gas Enterprise (M.O.G.E) Pipeline.

The Rotech Subsea TRS2 tool was selected by Pathfinder Technical Services for this workscope due to the increased productivity and controllability over any other excavation tool in the market.

The TRS2 spread of equipment work was mobilised in Singapore on the 5th December 2017 onboard the Crest Hydra DSV vessel and de-mobbed on the 29th December also from Singapore.

The TRS2 CFE tool was operated by the experienced Rotech CFE Team to rectify 17 areas of freespan to ensure the pipeline is fully supported along the route. The Soils in the area were found to be soft clay. The freespan rectification operation was completed in a timely manner ensuring the project was completed within the schedule advised by Rotech Subsea
